Check in with your Coach for sign-up events.

Most coaches have completed forms for sign-up events, the team roster, and ethics pledge. Thank you so much!

We will release a sign-up event schedule on Wednesday, March 6, so we can put together a schedule that works well for our volunteers. There will be limited available testing spots for sign-up events after this date.

Decide to Attend (or Skip) the Opening and Closing Ceremony.

We have two ceremonies planned during the Science Olympiad tournament. **Both** will be held in Bauccio Commons and both are optional.

The Opening (Welcome) Ceremony will be at 8:40 am and last approximately to 9:00 am. The Closing (Awards) Ceremony will be at 5:30 pm and last approximately to 6:30 pm. Awards not picked up at the ceremony will be mailed to coaches.
